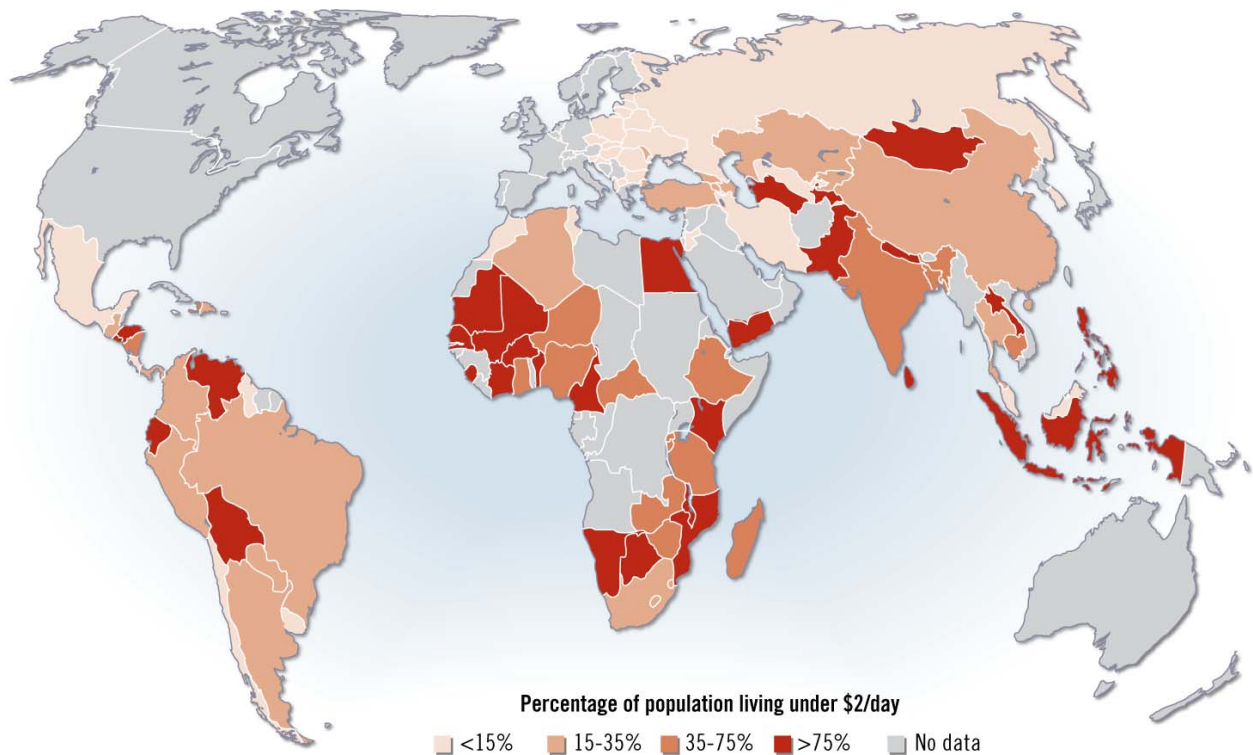


People living on less than US\$ 2/day

In the world today, nearly half the population- some 2.6 billion people - are very poor and survive on less than 2 dollars per day. Of those, three quarters live in rural areas. For many the world's poor, at least 50-70% of their incomes go toward buying food, leaving little for health, education, and other basic needs such as shelter and clothing.
